The Hesketh range of white label wines represent the best of our home state, South Australia - one of the most celebrated and diverse growing regions in the world.

Grapes for these wines are grown only in premium sub regions of South Australia which are best suited to each wine style. The wines are then blended before bottling to a fresh, fruit driven style which is perfect for everyday drinking - or more salubrious occasions.

Background

Fruit for Midday Somewhere Shiraz comes from the Wrattenbully, McLaren Vale and Currency Creek growing regions in South Australia.

The moderate climate of these regions results in extended ripening periods for Shiraz which enhances flavour development. This translates into bright, aromatic Shiraz with distinctive varietal flavour and character.

Tasting Notes

- Colour:** Dark cherry red with bright purple hues.
- Aroma:** Dark berry fruits, mocha, vanilla, cedar and coffee with hints of dried herbs.
- Palate:** Generous and ripe, but with a seam of spicy elegance which has been retained by not allowing the fruit to over ripen. Hints of vanilla from the American oak complements the dark chocolate and spicy licorice on the finish. Primary fruit and oak flavours are balanced neatly with natural acidity and soft tannins, to provide restraint and elegance to the persistent finish.

Food Match: Roast Lamb. Steak. Pizza.

Cellaring: 5 to 8 years.
