The Hesketh range of white label wines represent the best of our home state, South Australia - one of the most celebrated and diverse growing regions in the world.

Grapes for these wines are grown only in premium sub regions of South Australia which are best suited to each wine style. The wines are then blended before bottling to a fresh, fruit driven style which is perfect for everyday drinking - or more salubrious occasions.

Background

Fruit for Midday Somewhere Shiraz comes from the McLaren Vale and Langhorne Creek growing regions in South Australia.

The moderate climate of these regions results in extended ripening periods for Shiraz which enhances flavour development.

This translates into bright, aromatic Shiraz with dark fruits, spice and distinctive varietal character.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep ruby red

Aroma: Ripe raspberry and cherry notes, coffee, spice and vanilla.

Palate: Generous and bold with a slight hint of white pepper spice. The oak integration has balanced the primary fruit characters nicely, allowing for a ripe finish of berry notes.

Hints of vanilla and chocolate are prevalent throughout without being overpowering. Soft tannins and natural acidity provide restraint and elegance until the lingering end.

Food Match: Braised beef cheek. Roast lamb

Cellaring: 5 to 8 years.
