## TWIST OF FATE 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

The Hesketh range of white label wines represent the best of our home state, South Australia - one of the most celebrated and diverse growing regions in the world.

Grapes for these wines are grown only in premium dry-grown sub regions of South Australia which are best suited to each wine style. The wines are then blended before bottling to a fresh, fruit driven style which is perfect for everyday drinking - or more salubrious occasions.

### Background

Fruit for this wine comes from the Currency Creek and McLaren Vale growing regions on the Fleurieu Peninsula in South Australia. The moderate climate of both regions results in extended ripening periods for Cabernet Sauvignon which enhances flavour development. This translates into bright, aromatic Cabernet with distinctive varietal flavour and character.

### Tasting Notes

- Colour:** Dark cherry red with bright purple hues.
- Aroma:** Dark berry fruits and violets with hints of tobacco and dried herbs.
- Palate:** Generous and ripe, but with a seam of spicy elegance which has been retained by not allowing the fruit to over ripen. Hints of cedary oak with dark berry fruits. Primary fruit and oak flavours are balanced neatly with natural acidity to provide a generous middle palate and persistent finish.
- Food Match:** Pizza
- Cellaring:** 5 to 8 years.
