TWIST OF FATE 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon

The Hesketh range of white label wines represent the best of our home state, South Australia - one of the most celebrated and diverse growing regions in the world.

Grapes for these wines are grown only in premium dry-grown sub regions of South Australia which are best suited to each wine style. The wines are then blended before bottling to a fresh, fruit driven style which is perfect for everyday drinking - or more salubrious occasions.

Background

Fruit for our Twist of Fate Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from a selection of premium vineyards within the South Australian growing region. To accentuate the bright moreish fruit notes and create an vibrant, aromatic style of wine we have restricted the use of oak during fermentation.

The result is a medium-bodied, youthful style of Cabernet that can well and truly be enjoyed immediately but will also deepen in flavour with careful cellaring.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Inky garnet red with softer purple rim.

Aroma: Powerful Cabernet nose: violets, berries, dried herbs

Palate: Bright and juicy with generous notes of ripe dark-berry fruits alongside lovely roasted coffee beans and a slick of cedar. Generous mouth feel without losing the seam of elegance that Twist of Fate is renowned for. Firm, grippy tannins lead into a long and mouthwatering finish.

Food Match: Homemade pork and beef Ragu.

Cellaring: 5 to 8 years.
